Juneteenth Celebration Parade Rules

Entrants must observe all the rules and regulations listed below. Also, entrants must always follow all instructions from police and parade officials on parade day. The Juneteenth Celebration Committee reserves the right to remove any entrants from the parade point. Removal can occur before assembly, during assembly, or during the parade.

1. No one can throw materials (candy) along the parade route. Walkers will not be allowed to hand materials to spectators.
2. All teams must close the gap between entrants when instructed by parade officials.
3. Alcoholic beverages are forbidden on any vehicle and any participants.
4. Participants consuming alcohol before or during the parade will be removed from the lineup by the city police department.
5. All vehicle drivers in the parade areas must possess a valid driver's license.
6. Be at least 18 years old and have liability vehicle insurance.
7. The use of high-intensity sound-making devices is strongly discouraged.
8. Political campaigning is not permitted. Politicians are welcome to participate in the parade, but handing out material, flyers, etc., is not allowed.
